Personal Essentials Pantry (PEP) Donation Information

About

The Personal Essentials Pantry is a service offered weekly at the Catholic Multicultural Center (CMC). Our PEP works in conjunction with the PEP Atwood pantry in Madison to offer standard-sized hygiene products to clients. The pantry is open each Tuesday from 1-3:30 p.m. Registration occurs at the front desk from 1-3 p.m. Weekly eligibility for items per client is dependent upon family size and product lifespan. Families can use the pantry as often as needed. The pantry serves an average of over 700 households a year.

How to Donate

Thank you for your interest in donating to the CMC PEP! In order to make a donation, please bring items to the CMC front desk during business hours (weekdays 9 a.m.-5 p.m.). Please do **not** bring donation items during pantry hours from 1-4 p.m. on Tuesdays.

Acceptable Items

The CMC accepts the following standard size (not travel or jumbo size) items for donation:

- Toothpaste
- Toothbrushes (adult and children's)
- Shampoo
- Bar soap
- **Dish soap**
- **Men's and women's deodorant**
- Toilet paper
- Standard plastic grocery/shopping bags to distribute items to clients
